Dear Parents

A study visit has been arranged for Food Technology students in Years 10, 11, 12 and 13 to the Food Show at the NEC, Birmingham, leaving school at 8.10am and returning at approximately 5.15pm on Wednesday 25th November 2009. The aim of the trip is to increase awareness of current trends and new food products amongst GCSE and A Level students.
