A study visit has been arranged for students in Years 12 & 13 to 'Bath Theatre Royal' to watch a performance of 'Lord Arthur Savile's Crime', starting at 7.30pm and finishing at approximately 10.30pm on Tuesday, 20th April 2010. The aim of the trip is to enrich the learning experience of pupils.

The cost of the trip is £9.25. This covers the cost of the ticket for the performance. We are asking pupils to make their own way to and from the theatre and **they should be there in good time for the performance to start at 7.30pm**. Students should make their own way home when the performance finishes at 10.30 pm.
