Dear Parents / Guardians

We have arranged a visit to the Bristol Synagogue for all Year 8 Students. The aim of this visit is to complement their PSRE work on Judaism.

The students will go on the trip within their normal lesson time on one of the following dates – 24th November 2009, 12th January 2010 and 2nd February 2010.

The cost of the trip will be £5.

The school is not able to provide financial support for such visits and, therefore, we seek a voluntary contribution of £5 towards the cost of the trip. We regret to say that if insufficient funds are received the trip will have to be cancelled. We must also state that we would be unable to return any monies as a consequence of the late withdrawal of a student after money has been paid unless the withdrawal is as a consequence of illness.

If your child is receiving medication or treatment for a medical condition at the time of the trip please could you indicate this on the reverse of the permission slip at the bottom of this letter.

Boys will need some sort of head covering in the Synagogue and girls are requested to wear skirts rather than trousers unless their own religious requirements demand otherwise.
