What happens during Induction Days?



Day 1 – Thursday 10 July is all about 'getting to know you'. Only new Y7 students will be in the school, so you'll have a chance to get to know your tutor group and find your way around Sheldon. This is a good time to ask all the questions you may have about secondary school.

Where is my classroom?

Where do I eat my lunch?

Who is my tutor?

What friends are in my class?

What are the teachers like?

And many more!

Day 2 – Friday 11 July you will experience a typical school day. You will follow a timetabled schedule and attend some of the lessons you will have in Year 7. You will also see what it is like at break and lunchtime with students from other year groups in school.

What should I wear?

Please wear your normal primary uniform and bring your primary PE kit. You do not need a Sheldon uniform for Induction Days.

What should I bring?

Please bring a pen/pencil, colour pencils, ruler and a notebook. You should also bring a PE kit and water bottle.



What will I eat?

During our Induction Days you will have the opportunity to try the delicious food in our Refectory during break and lunchtime. You can also bring a packed lunch.

Who is in my Tutor Group?

Mrs Laura Hall (Head of Year) or Miss Anna Clancy (Deputy Head of Year) will visit primary schools in the upcoming weeks to talk to pupils, headteachers and class teachers. This will help decide how tutor groups are formed.

We would like each pupil to have at least one friend in the group. Tutor groups should be about the same size and have roughly the same number of boys and girls. We also try to have a mix of pupils from different primary schools in the group.

At the beginning of July you will receive a letter detailing tutor group and further information about our Induction Days.

All tutor groups will be taught Spanish and either French or German.
