Term	Topics	Skills	Assessment
1&2	Being New	Freezeframes, role plays, adopting a credible role, teacher in role, poetry as a stimulus for abstract piece using movement, levels, narration, sound collage, choral speaking.	Class discussion, pair performances assessed by teacher and peers, questioning. All assessment is practical.
3&4	Haunted House	All the above skills and more fluid whole class teacher in role. Pupils create a longer, more sustained piece based on a ghost story. Text is used as stimulus and performance of text extracts and create a simple backstory to text.	As above. Additionally, pupils are assessed on longer performance pieces by their peers and teacher using criteria of skills in group work.
5&6	Play Text – Face Value	Using skills learnt in terms 1-4 and developing more sophisticated characterisation skills. Greater focus on verbal and non-verbal skills e.g. projection, use of pause, pitch, tone, emphasis, body language, gestures, proxemics.	As above. Additionally, pupils are assessed on their use of performance skills and characterisation using text.
