1&2	"Inspector Calls" – pupils explore how the complete text can be interpreted from page to stage. Pupils need to understand the play from the perspective of director, actor and designer.	Exploration of verbal and non-verbal skills and drama language taught. Play is explored through practical activities including freezeframes, role plays, performing extracts from the text. Design skills are taught with a focus on set and costume. Drama terminology is taught.	Understanding of play in performance is assessed through practical work in lessons and weekly written homework tasks. The focus for both written and practical tasks is working towards an understanding of exam questions.

3	Component 2: 20%	Pupils work in groups and rehearse two key extracts from a play for a final performance to an external examiner. This is an acting exam and pupils' skills in all aspects of performance will be marked. The skill of learning lines is taught in lessons.
