Dear Parents and Carers,

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I am wishing you a Happy New Year and I am pleased to report it has been a really positive return to school in term 3. This term we are having a focus on equipment and routines during tutor time and are checking students' equipment every day, so that we ensure that they have the right equipment to learn. We have given tutors and Heads of Year spare equipment, so students never arrive to lessons unequipped. A reminder that students should have the following:

# Assemblies and upcoming Ofsted visit

Last week I delivered assemblies on our school values, and I reminded students about the new equipment and spaces they have available to them at break and lunchtime. I also talked about our upcoming visit from Ofsted, which will happen any time from next term. I talked about what Ofsted asked us to improve during their last visit in December 2022 and what a crucial part the students had to play in the outcome of the inspection. When we get the notification, I will write to you to let you know where you can give feedback about the school, its leadership and the experience your child gets. You also have an important role to play in completing the Ofsted questionnaire.

## **Rescheduled Inset Day**

Due to the number of changes that I have made since my arrival, I have had to reschedule a training day into this term, and this will be on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February. This has been moved from Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July, which was Turnaround Day 1 (all students will now be in school on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July). Rescheduling the day will enable

me to have dedicated time with my staff to ensure the whole school priorities are delivered and that students continue to get a great experience. This inset day will focus on explicit vocabulary instruction and how best to support students who are vulnerable and on the SEND register. During this day, some SEND students and their parents will be invited in to review their child's SEND plan and carry out a review of their provision.
