Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well and that you and your family have enjoyed a restful and enjoyable summer break. As we begin the new academic year, I am delighted to welcome back our returning families and extend a very special welcome to our new Year 7 and Year 12 students, and to the parents who are joining our school community for the first time.

#### **Return to School**

School begins as normal for all students on **Wednesday**, except Year 12, who will return on **Thursday**. Timetables are now available on Epraise, and paper copies will also be issued to students during tutor time. Earlier this week, our pastoral leads shared reminders about equipment and uniform expectations. These will continue to be a focus during tutor time so that every student is equipped and ready to learn in each lesson. Please note that we have added some items to the *essential equipment list*, so do check this carefully.

### **Summer Improvements**

The start of a new school year always brings a sense of excitement and opportunity. Alongside staff preparing lessons to ensure every child feels supported and inspired, our site team have been hard at work improving our facilities over the summer.

#### **Highlights include:**

- Painting and decorating across the school, with new carpets in key areas.
- Upgraded ICT facilities, including new computers and an extended music suite.
- A new photography dark room.
- Refurbished Year 7, 8 and 9 toilets.
- New internal and external doors to improve safety and appearance.
- Basketball hoops fitted in the Year 8–11 playgrounds.
- Additional play equipment for break and lunchtime.
- Six new electric vehicle charging points at the front of the school, available for staff, parents, and visitors, as part of our commitment to becoming a net-zero school.

We are proud of these improvements and hope students will both enjoy and respect the new facilities.

#### Training Days - What Did We Do?

When my youngest child asked me what an "insect day" was and why he couldn't see the insects, I thought it would be useful to share what actually happens on our training days!

This year, our professional development focused on teaching and learning approaches inspired by Doug Lemov's *Teach Like a Champion*. Staff trained on three key strategies — **Show Call, Show Me, and Entry/Exit routines** — which build on the work we've been developing over the last two years.

We also completed our annual safeguarding, child protection, and SEN training, ensuring that all staff are well prepared to support students' safety and wellbeing.

Finally, we introduced our new homework platform, **SENECA**, following strong recommendations from our School Council, who had found it extremely valuable when preparing for exams last year. We believe this will enhance the quality of homework across the school, particularly supporting Years 11 and 13 with revision, but also benefitting younger students preparing for end-of-topic tests. Parents and students will receive more information about SENECA later this term.

## **Safeguarding Update**

Over the summer, we installed new fences and gates at the front of the school to further secure the site during the day, evenings, and weekends. **A reminder:** if you are visiting during school hours, please report to the main reception via the main car park, as all other entrances are locked.
