Year 11 Revision Evening – Thursday 25th September 2025

Year 11 have settled in well to the new term, which is going to be a busy one for Year 11! As well as focusing on reviewing the progress that students have made so far in their GCSE studies, we will be supporting them in preparing for the in-class mocks that they will sit in October 2025 and the formal Mocks that they will sit in January 2026. The purpose of the evening is to:

- Ensure that you and your child are aware of where to access specification content.
- Ensure that you and your child are aware of how they will be assessed in subject areas and particularly in English and Maths.
- Deepen understanding about the importance of retrieval practice and interleaving, and the science behind learning and memory.
- Share revision techniques and strategies that your child can utilise in the lead up to their internal assessments, and in preparation for their GCSE examinations next summer.

Where shown, English and Science will have mocks in half year groups. For example, if your child is in a left-side tutor group, they will have English on Tuesday 14th October during lesson 3-4 and if in a right-side tutor group they will have English on Thursday 16th October during lessons 1-2.

For option subjects, the subject mocks will take place in students' double options lessons over this two-week period according to the block that they are in, and the timings are shown above. To understand which subject is in which block for your child, simply look at their timetable on Epraise. The capital letter that comes after the number 11 tells you which block that subject is taught in. In the example below History is in Block C and Spanish in Block D, therefore the Spanish mock for this student will be on Monday 6th October in lesson 3-4 and History will be on Monday 13th October lesson 1-2

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Before the revision evening, subject teachers will provide students with a list of topics on epraise that are being assessed so that students can focus on the content that they need to revise. This may be set centrally in each subject and by a teacher that is not your child's usual teacher but the heading will contain the term Year 11 Mocks. Other homework will continue to be set in each subject area as teaching continues until the start of the in-class Mock fortnight.
